TERMS AND CONDITIONS



1. Adhere to the KCBS Rules, Regulations and Judging Procedures (if you need copies please let the organizer know).
2. Adhere to the State of NJ Fire Marshal's Fire Safety Regulations. A permit is required and available by calling 732-854-8000.
3. The selling of BBQ Samples is **prohibited**.
4. The selling of t-shirts, mugs, pins are permitted, but must pertain only to your BBQ Team.
5. Cooking equipment cannot be displayed for resale purposes.
6. Banners at cook site are to be tasteful and non-offensive.
7. Tents are permitted and to be no bigger than the allotted slot of 20'x20' or 20'x30' and must be flame retardant. Cooking units cannot be placed directly under the tent.
8. Each cook site must possess a fire extinguisher.
9. Liability Waiver, contained in the Competitor Application, must be signed and dated.
10. An Award Information Form (available at check-in) will be requested for submittal.
11. Registration and load in time will be from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, September 25, 2009 as well as 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 26, 2009. Welcome Party Friday night from 7:00-8:00 p.m.
12. All competitors should be in place and set up no later than 2:00 p.m. Saturday, September 26, 2009.
13. Mandatory Cook's Meeting on Saturday, September 26, 2009 at 3:00 p.m.
14. Meat Inspection will commence around 10:00 a.m. on Saturday the 26th.
15. Rules for after Competition Hours:

CAUSES FOR DISQUALIFICATION & EVICTION of a team, its members and/or guests:

A cook team is responsible for its head cook, its team members and its guests.

- a. No person shall serve alcoholic beverages to the general public.
- b. Use of illegal controlled substances.
- c. Foul, abusive or unacceptable language or any language causing a disturbance.
- d. Excessive noise generated from speakers or public address systems. Quiet time will start at 10:00 p.m. on contest nights and will last until 7:00 a.m. The use of radios or amplifying equipment will not be allowed during this time period.
- e. Fighting or disorderly conduct.
- f. Theft, dishonesty, cheating, use of prohibited meats, or any act involving moral depravity.
- g. Use of gas or other auxiliary heat sources inside the cooking device.



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Violation of any of the KCBS Cook's Rules.

Excessive or continued complaints from teams on any of the stated rules infractions shall be considered grounds for immediate disqualification from the contest by KCBS Representatives, Organizers and/or Security.

In addition, any violation of the stated rules shall be reported to the KCBS Board of Directors who may in addition to the above disqualification impose additional penalties upon the team, the head cook, and its members including, but not limited to, disqualification from competing in KCBS events for a period of time not to exceed five years.

All complaints of disturbance or violation of quiet time shall be reported to the BBQ Organizer.

- Turn-in times will be announced at the Cook's Meeting.
- Award time will be announced at the Cook's Meeting.
- Breakdown time will be coordinated with the BBQ Organizer. Departing will commence once all awards have been issued and will follow the BBQ Organizers instructions for exiting.
