Be It Resolved by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

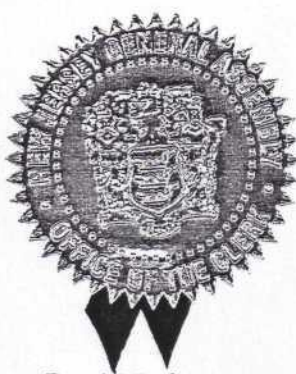
